Our Facilities

Lewis Children's Center is located on the corner of Brook and Parham Roads, just off I-95. The campus was originally built as an orphanage and school and has a series of "cottages" around four central buildings: the gymnasium, the original school building, the administration building and the chapel. (FYI, St. Joseph's Villa is not affiliated with any religious organization, and welcome people of all faiths.)



Our infant, toddler, two-year-old and three-year-old classrooms are located in Cottage 5, just behind the administration building. The three-year-old classroom is shown at left.

Our four-year-old and preschool classrooms, as well as our after-school programs, are in Janet's Place, which is located in an addition to the Villa gymnasium.
