ST. JOSEPH'S VILLA COMPLETES STEAM DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM REPLACEMENT

Major campus redevelopment project to begin in next month

Richmond, VA – St. Joseph's Villa has completed its project to replace the underground steam distribution system on the Villa campus at Brook and Parham Roads. The project began in late spring 2010 and has been fully tested in preparation for the cold weather this fall and winter. The project was completed at a cost of approximately \$2.4 million, approximately \$700,000 under budget.
